

Glossary – People in Vienna

Birth/death ratio

Number of live births minus deaths.

Central Register of Residence (CRR)

The Central Register of Residence is the largest administrative register of Austria, which stores domiciles of inhabitants and reflects the reporting reality. The CRR forms also the central data basis for the data base system POPREG of Statistics Austria. The POPREG considers from the demographic point of view certain residence criteria for the collection of the number of inhabitants and shall reflect the demographic reality. In POPREG people for example are classed as permanent residents when a duration of residence of more than three months can be registered on the deadline date.

Labour force

Total number of employed and unemployed persons.

Net migration balance

Number of in-migrants minus out-migrants.

New forms of employment

This term comprises the categories “minimal employment” and “quasi-freelance service contracts” for employed persons and “new self-employed persons” for self-employed persons.

Population density

Number of inhabitants living on an area of 1 sq km.

Standard employment

Defined by the Association of Austrian Social Insurance Institutions as traditional full-time or part-time employment.

Types of childcare facilities

Day nurseries – for children up to 3 years of age

Kindergartens – for children between 3 and 6 years of age

After-school care clubs – for schoolchildren between 6 and 10 years of age

Mixed-age daycare

for children between 0 and 6 years of age and

for children between 3 and 10 years of age

Unemployment rate (EU rate)

The EU rate as the international unemployment rate is calculated on the basis of the Austrian Labour Force Survey, which makes use of the international definition of unemployment.

According to the Labour Force Concept (LFC), unemployed persons are those without work, who actively seek work, and are available to start work. The rate is the number of persons unemployed as a percentage of the labour force, again calculated on the basis of the LFC.

Unemployment rate (registered rate)

The registered rate as national unemployment rate is calculated on the basis of persons registered as unemployed with the Labour Market Services and persons registered as employed with the Association of Austrian Social Insurance Institutions and comprises all

persons seeking work for a given period through the available channels. It corresponds to the share of persons registered as unemployed in the labour force, which is defined as the total number of employed and unemployed persons.

Unemployment/vacancy ratio

Number of registered unemployed persons per registered vacancy.
