CLEAR GLASS

- clear non-returnable glass bottles, e.g. for juice, wine or seed oils
- clear jars such as jam, pickle or preserving jars (completely emptied)
- clear perfume bottles

COLOURED GLASS

- coloured non-returnable glass bottles, e.g. for juice, wine or seed oils
- coloured jars such as jam, pickle or preserving jars (completely emptied)
- coloured perfume bottles

PLEASE NO MIRRORS, WINDOW PANES, DRINKING GLASSES OR VASES

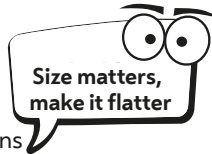


ALL PACKAGING EXCEPT PAPER AND GLASS

- plastic bottles
- beverage cartons
- plastic film, packaging and bubble wrap
- fruit punnets, yoghurt containers (remove lid)
- lightweight packaging, bioplastic packaging
- metal packaging, tins

Please return glass bottles, PET bottles and beverage cans featuring the return logo to a retailer near you.

PLEASE NO APPLIANCES, BATTERIES, ENERGY-SAVING LAMPS



CLEAN PAPER AND SMALL CARDBOARD PACKAGING



- clear paper or cardboard packaging, e.g. non-coated frozen food packaging
- newspapers, magazines
- catalogues, brochures
- writing or drawing paper
- letters and envelopes (including window envelopes)
- paper bags
- small cardboard packaging and boxes – but please fold them first!

PLEASE TAKE BIG PIECES OF CARDBOARD TO THE WASTE COLLECTION CENTRE



VIENNA'S ORGANIC WASTE BIN IS VEGAN

- garden waste such as lawn clippings and hedge trimmings
- leaves and branches (up to 8cm diameter)
- plant-based kitchen waste like fruit and vegetable scraps – but please only uncooked and unseasoned!
- bioplastic bags only when used to collect organic waste
- potted plants, cut flowers

GARDEN OWNERS:

You can take up to 2m³ of tree or hedge cuttings and leaves to the waste collection centres for free.

PLEASE NO COOKED OR ANIMAL-BASED SCRAPS, NO BIOPLASTIC PACKAGING



ANY WASTE THAT CAN'T BE REUSED

- food scraps, eggshells, bones, meat, fish
- household and sanitary papers such as tissues, kitchen roll, napkins, paper towels
- tableware, drinking glasses, pottery, ceramics, porcelain
- nappies, pet litter, dog waste bags, sweepings
- small children's toys (dolls, mixed materials)
- photos, wallpaper scraps (in small amounts)
- old, unusable textiles
- thermal paper such as receipts, lotto coupons, etc.

PLEASE NO HAZARDOUS WASTE, APPLIANCES, BULKY WASTE OR BUILDING RUBBLE

WASTE COLLECTION CENTRES

Vienna's waste collection centres allow Viennese households to dispose of bulky waste, scrap materials and hazardous waste. For example:

- large pieces of cardboard • bulky waste • household appliances • cleaning agents, varnishes • batteries
